Creative

Create a bulletin board with train tracks, a train engine and multiple train cars cut out of construction paper. Label each car with the number "50" or whatever number is decided upon as a visual marker of items brought in. Example: every time 50 food items are donated, add a train car to the train.

With the school coordinator, decide a good place to store the items brought in by the student body. At the end of every school day, count the number of items and report the number to the Creative Crew so they can add a train car to the train.

Action

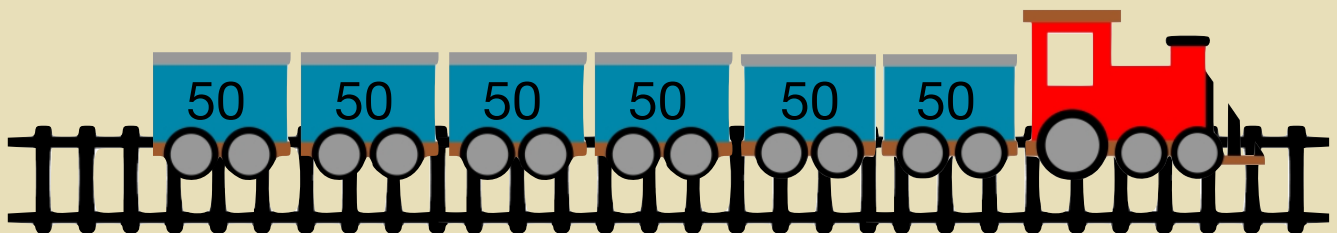
Another option: To create competition within the grades, create a train for each grade level on the same bulletin board. Add the train cars to the trains to show the progress of the competition and the grade level in the lead.
