INSTRUCTIONS

- Ask each student and staff to make a *Holiday Card of Appreciation* with a sentiment of appreciation for any organization or person that they think makes their community a better place to live.
- You may want to narrow down the organizations by asking the G-Force to identify a few organizations in your community that are making a difference.



- Ideas: food bank, pet shelter, homeless, women's shelter, mayor, police, firemen, newspaper, etc.
- Cards can be collected in a box.
- Then the G-Force divides the cards into large envelopes and delivers/sends them to the organizations honored.
